VIBRANT ECONOMY-

In April 2016, the Real Estate Investment Network stated that:

"The future seems to have discovered Abbotsford, even before Abbotsford discovered itself fully. In fact, in a number of independent reports Abbotsford is forecast to be one of the top three economic leaders in the Province."



Thirty-eight volunteers – from elected officials to representatives from business organizations – participated and connected with 143 businesses and gained valuable insight into what local busineses need and would like to see from the City in the future.

FLOOD MITIGATION

\$4 million in funding received from the Province of BC to protect our community from the flood risks posed by the erosion arcs in the Fraser River.

In 2015, the City of Abbotsford once again received the **Canadian Award for Financial Reporting** from the Government Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA).



Received:

\$57,000 of grant funding for restoration and innovative forestry initiatives, \$18,000 for improving walkability in the Clearbrook area for "Seniors Take a Walk" and \$10,000 for healthy lifestyle program MEND for families.



Expanded online services to make it easier to access city information from home.

Fire Rescue Service replaced Fire Hall 4 and Fire Hall 5 and saved a total of \$600,000 by building two identical fire halls at the same time with one contractor.

Re-organized external service delivery departments to reflect a more process driven structure which streamlines decision making and increases our service delivery capacity.

In 2015, Council endorsed a new 2015-2018 Strategic Plan, establishing an exciting vision for the City and providing direction and guidance as our City develops. At the core of the Strategic Plan is Council's overall vision for the City: Abbotsford is the Hub of the Fraser Valley.
