## What is your Emergency Plan?

Emergencies can happen at anytime, anywhere. The best way to be prepared is to have a plan **BEFORE** an emergency happens.

Take time to talk with members of your household and talk about what you're going to do when that emergency happens – where are you going to stay, Who are you going to contact, a list of important numbers to call for help such as insurance broker.

## Things to think about when making your plan:



Do you have your grab and go bag ready? A Grab and Go bag is a small emergency kit that's easy to take with you. You should have one for home, work and vehicle.



Research Insurance Plans – having insurance can protect you from having to pay out a huge amount in the event of a natural disaster – find a local insurance representative or call the Insurance Bureau of Canada at 1-844-227-5422.



Have an out of area contact – OUTSIDE of your same living area for ALL family members to contact and coordinate reporting in to ensure everyone is accounted for.



Where are you going if you're evacuated? Make a plan with family, friends and have an Emergency kit placed at that location so you have a change of clothes, important documents etc.



Make a 72 Hour Emergency Kit suited for your family and pets. Check out Prepare BC for more info on Making an Emergency Plan and Building emergency kits.
