PEARDONVILLE HOUSE FOR WOMEN

Peardonville House IRT and Mollies Place Stabilization Beds

...are located in a beautiful rural area of Abbotsford. The Centre was founded in 1987 as an intensive residential treatment centre for women. In 1990, at the request of the provincial government, the Mom and Tots program was launched to allow women struggling with addiction to bring their under-age children to treatment with them and have them share in the treatment experience. The two facilities are licensed under the Community Care and Assisted Living Act and funded annually by Fraser Health Authority as well as CSC and other partners. To date, British Columbia has no other publicly funded or private intensive residential treatment for women, that has a licensed Daycare facility. Services and programs are offered, utilizing a trauma informed lens.



KINGHAVEN FOR MEN

Kinghaven IRT and Valley House Stabilization Beds

Kinghaven Treatment Centre was established in 1971 as MSA Halfway House. Over the past 45 years it has evolved into one of the country's premier intensive residential treatment centres having served in excess of 28,000 adult men who present with problematic use of mood-altering substances or addictions. Located in the tranquil Fraser Valley of British Columbia, our campus also includes the George Schmidt Centre, a 31 unit second-stage housing facility for men and our newest project, located on the ground of Kinghaven, which will include a second, 5-6 story second stage house for men.

Services/Models

- Intensive bed based addictions treatment centres – Kinghaven and Peardonville House – 70 day program
- Stabilization beds – Valley House and Mollies Place – up to 30 days
- Addiction treatment services funded by FHA and CSC
- Primarily serving residents of the FH catchment area
- Second stage housing for men – GSC
- Second stage housing for women

- Individual & group counselling
- Music therapy
- Art therapy
- All Nations programming
- Peer support groups
- DBT skills
- Making Sense of Pain
- Employment Readiness Program

Men's Programming

- Mindfulness based relapse prevention & Self-compassion mindfulness
- Understanding codependency
- St. John's Ambulance therapy dog program
- Non-Violent Communication

Women's Programming

- Relapse prevention planning
- Healthy relationships
- Parenting classes
- Grief and loss

- Individual trauma therapy with RCC

- Maintenance, IT, Client Services Assistants
- Food services
