- VAWIR adopted this campaign and in October of every year has participated in "Purple Light Nights"

- ► This campaign is in remembrance of the victims who lost their lives from domestic violence, support those who survived intimate partner violence, and give hope to those who still live in abuse
- Purple Lights Nights is meant to increase the awareness of intimate partner violence and it's affect upon children and families

- Provide assistance and service referrals to victims and their families
- Work to support policies that meet victim needs and hold perpetrators accountable
