QUICK TIPS

for securing waste from wildlife

- ✓ Place carts at the curbside by 7 am on the morning of collection day and **NOT** the night before.
- ✓ Use bear resistant carts to deter wildlife from accessing cart contents.
- ✓ Minimize odours by freezing food scraps or wrapping them in newspaper and disposing of them on collection day.
- ✓ Keep carts clean and free from odour build up by rinsing with detergent or a vinegar solution.
- ✓ Store carts indoors or in a secure location.
- ✓ Ensure cart lids are closed and not overflowing.
- ✓ Rinse, clean, and dry any recyclables.

Hazardous materials like paint, batteries and household cleaning products need to be disposed of properly and taken to a drop-off site or recycling centre that accepts hazardous materials.



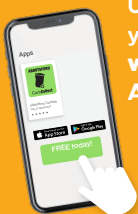
Grasscycle
