

Food Security Initiatives

- Community Food Action Initiative (CFAI)
 - Provide community grants to address food security across BC
 - Fraser Health Authority disseminates the provincial funds to grant recipients
 - 2022/2023 funding cycle: 10 grants in 11 communities



How is Population and Public Health involved with the CFAI initiative?

- Community Health Specialists and Public Health Dietitians participate at Healthier Community Partnerships and community food security tables
- Provide planning, leadership and advocacy support at the community level
- Guide activities at the community level to address food security
- Monitor activities through collecting food security data



CFAI Grantee: Archway Community Services

- Archway Food Justice Committee's Participatory Action Research related to Food Security in Abbotsford
- Research's objective: To assess food security among people with lived and living experience of food insecurity in Abbotsford, BC



CFAI Grantee: Archway Community Services

- To develop an approach and gain insight on food security challenges among:
 - People with lived and living experience of food insecurity
 - People accessing low and or no cost food options in Abbotsford
- Method: Conduct focus group discussions and survey questionnaires to collect information (63 focus group participants)
- CFAI grant covers:
 - Focus group honourariums
 - Cost to attend focus groups (transportation, childcare etc.)
