- ▶ 20 houses
- ▶ 12 suites

Scattered-Site Housing

- ▶ Of the 20 houses:
- 5 are exclusively Indigenous
- 6 are for women and one family house
- ▶ 12 are for men
- ▶ 1 for elderly women
- ▶ 1 for elderly men
- 5 are low barrier
- We currently have 12 suites (mostly 2-bdrm) for families, couples and individuals living more independently.
- Currently we are housing 124 people

Services

- Elder services
- 2 cultural camps each year
- Healing circles, drum circles, cultural ceremonies, cultural crafts
- Referrals to counselling, treatment and other supports
- Assistance with medical and other health related appointments
- Personal development and planning
- Assistance applying for employment and educational programs
- Assistance applying for financial assistance, housing and medical benefits
- Assistance and support working with child protection services
- Newly developing a vocational program and hiring a vocational counsellor.
- Newly hired an addiction counsellor.
