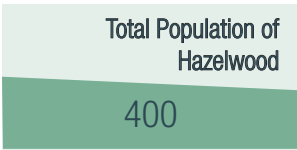

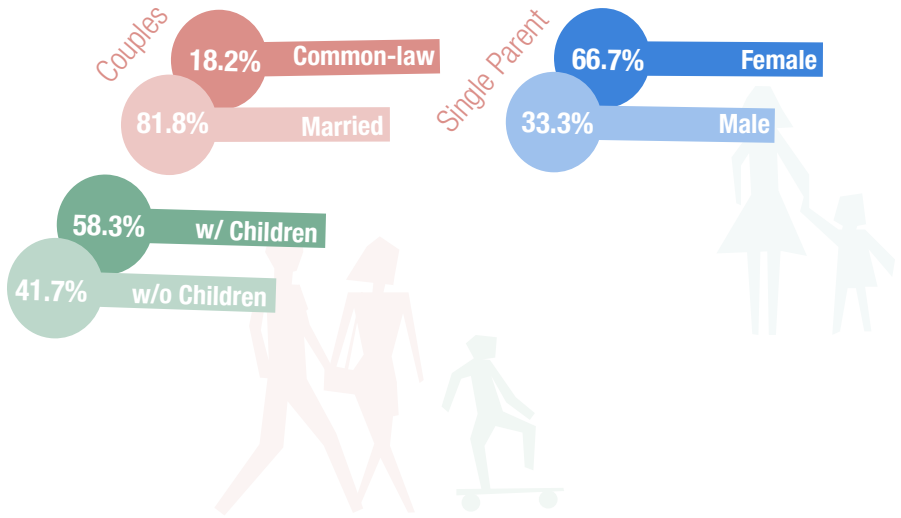

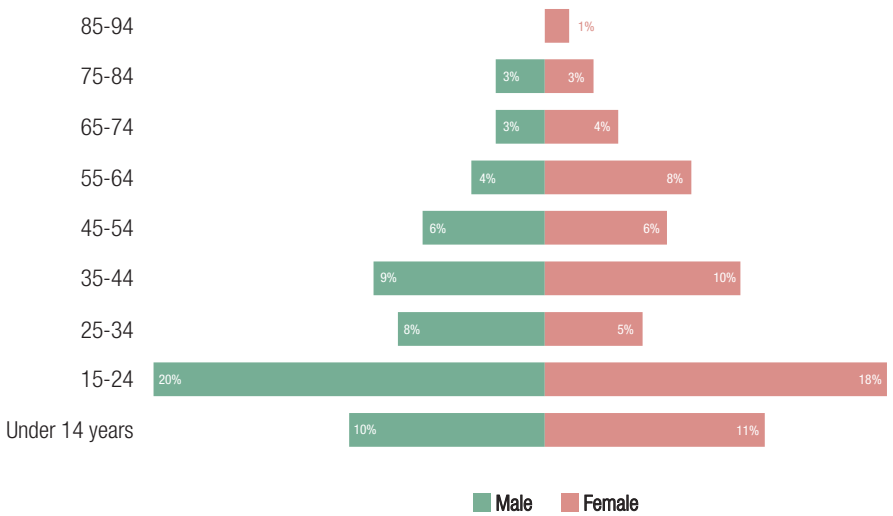

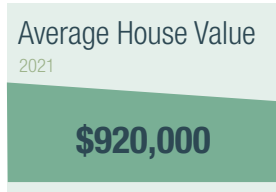
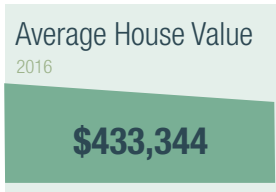
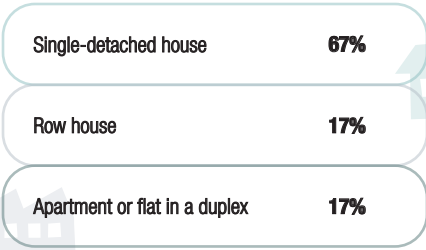
Family Structure



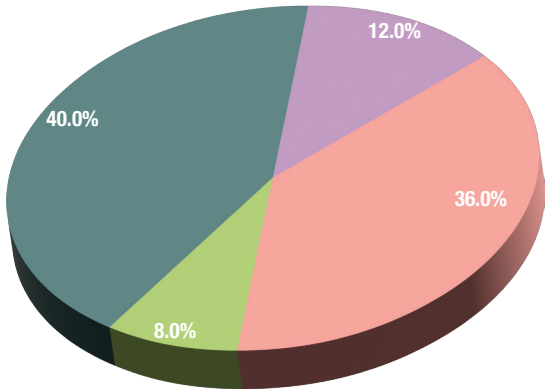
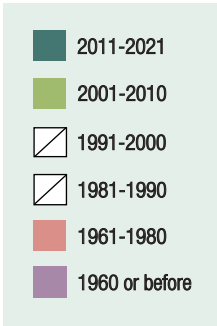
Age Distribution

In Canada, housing is considered unaffordable if it costs more than 30% of a household's before-tax income.

Owned Dwellings

Average monthly payments

2016: \$1,694

2021: \$1,924

In 2016, 20.1% of owner households were spending 30% or more of their income on (unaffordable) shelter costs. In 2021, the percentage of people with unaffordable payments lowered to 19.9%.

Rented Dwellings

2016: \$1,003

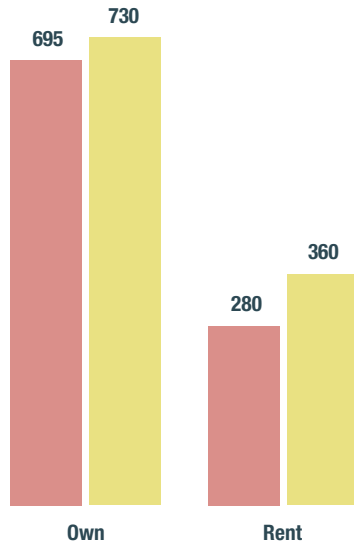
2021: \$1,585

In 2016, 26.8% of tenant households were spending 30% or more of their income on (unaffordable) shelter costs. In 2021, the percentage of people with unaffordable rent rose to 27.8%.

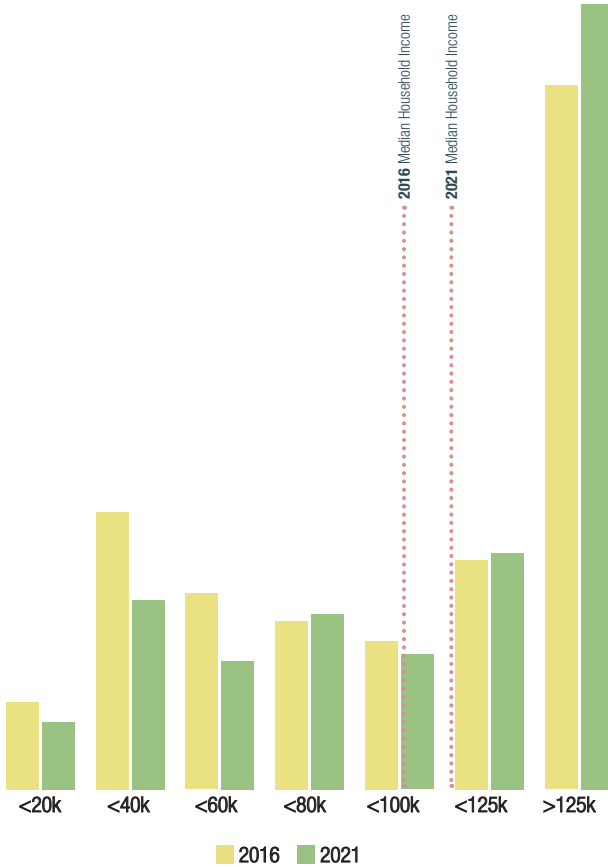

Since 2016, household incomes have risen by approximately 11%.



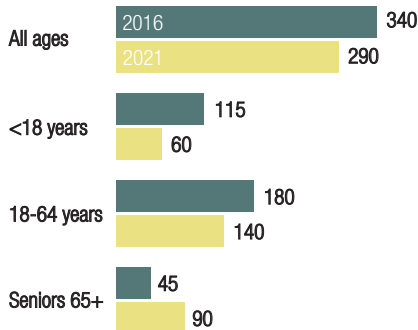
Median Individual Income

Total low-income residents (after tax)

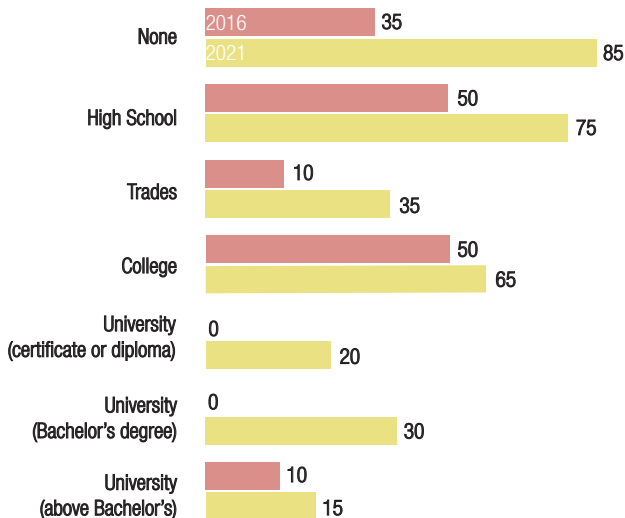


Low-Income definition

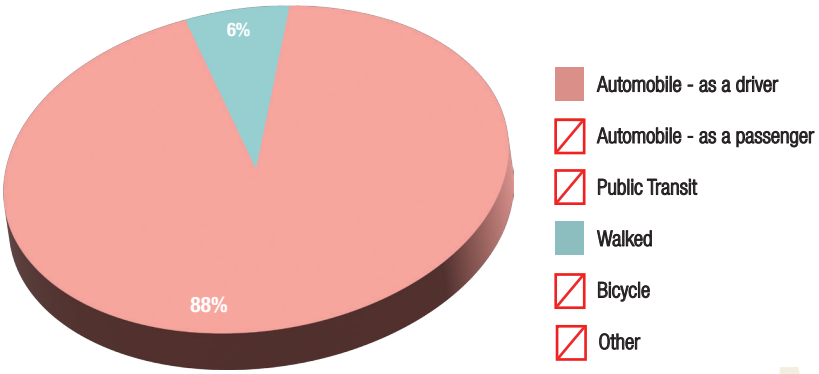
A household is considered “low income” if its total after-tax income is 50% of the median for households in Canada, adjusted for size.

Fewer people have attained higher education than 2016 levels.

6% of residents commuted to work using alternative means of transport than an automobile, down from 11% in 2016.

Construction and Manufacturing saw an increase, while Health Care and Social Assistance and Retail Trade saw a decrease.

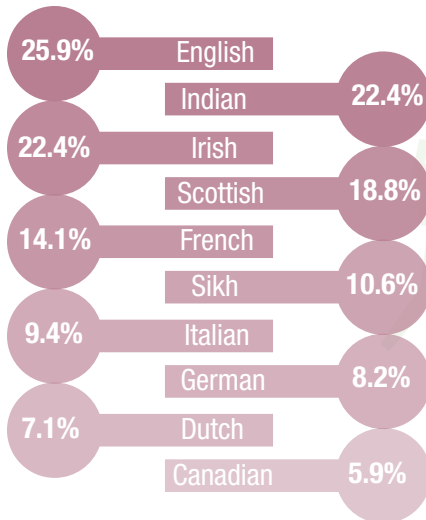

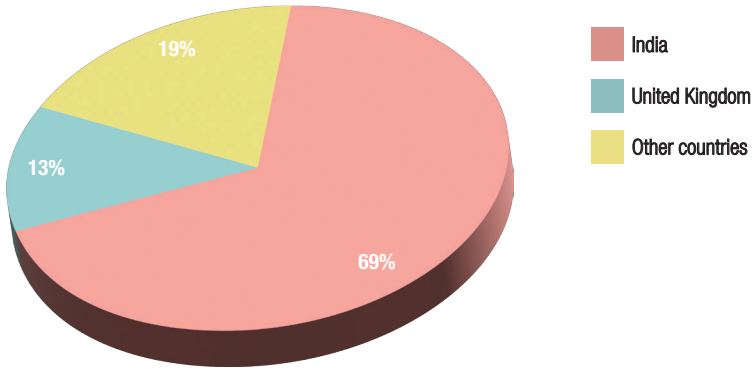


30.6% of Hazelwood residents are of a visible minority group.
