Utility Bills

Don't miss your bill due date and pay online, or in person at City Hall. The next payment due date for bi-monthly utility bills is **December 23, 2024**.

To view your current utility bill, login to your MyCity account at abbotsford.ca/mycity. If you do not have a MyCity account, you can sign up for an account. You will need your utility bill account number and access code found on your bi-monthly utility bill.

Payment Methods

CREDIT CARD ONLINE

Pay through the City's website at abbotsford.ca/creditcard. A 1.75% service fee applies to all credit card payments.

ONLINE BANKING

From your financial institution's website search for "Abbotsford" and select payee with "utilities". Use the 6 digit utility account number on the front of this bill as the account number.

IN PERSON AT CITY HALL

City Hall is open 8:30 am - 4:30 pm, Monday - Friday. Visit City Hall to learn your bill balance and pay your bill in person at the Cashiers window on the 1st floor. Please bring identification. Credit cards are **NOT** accepted at City Hall for utility payments.

A DROPBOX is available after hours for bill payments and is located at the front doors of City Hall. The dropbox is emptied daily. Please do not put cash in the dropbox.
