
Notice of Public Hearing

SUBJECT LANDS: 33309 Old Yale Road and 2714, 2728 and 2738 Fuller Street

CURRENT ZONING:

INSPIRE

Urban Residential Zone (RS3)

PROPOSED ZONING: Comprehensive


Development Seventy Four Zone (N74)

PURPOSE:

If Bylaw No. 2750-2017 is adopted, a new Comprehensive Development Seventy Four Zone (N74) will be created. The applicant proposes to rezone the subject properties from Urban Residential Zone (RS3) to the new Comprehensive Development Seventy Four Zone (N74), to permit a six storey 60 unit below market rental apartment building.

SUBJECT LAND: 3343 Townline Road

CURRENT ZONING: Country Residential Zone (CR)

PROPOSED ZONING: Urban Residential Zone (RS3), Residential Zone (RS5), Residential Zone (RS5-A), Medium Density Townhouse Zone (RM45), High Density Townhouse Zone (RM60), and Park, Open Space and School

PURPOSE:

If Bylaw No. 2748-2017 is adopted, the applicant proposes to rezone subject property to allow development of a 61 lot single-family subdivision, two townhouse development sites with a combined maximum possible density of 70 townhouses and the creation of neighbourhood parkland and natural open space to be transferred to the City.
