First Fraser Valley Regional Career Conference

ABBOTSFORD, March 29, 2018 – The first-ever Fraser Valley Career Connections and Conference (FVCCC) will take place in Abbotsford at the Fraser Valley Trade and Exhibition Centre (TRADEX) on April 5th 2018.

This regional career and job fair conference will match job-seekers from across Canada and the region with opportunities in the Fraser Valley labour market. FVCCC is a partnership between the City of Abbotsford, City of Langley, City of Chilliwack, Township of Langley, and Abbotsford Works.

With a booming economy, a young and diverse population and an abundance of business resources, the Fraser Valley is a place of opportunity. Strong labour demands across the region present an opportunity to connect job seekers with businesses that reside across the local communities.
