Neighbourhood Spirit Grant Successful Recipients

ABBOTSFORD – May 10, 2018: The City of Abbotsford is pleased to announce the 2018 Neighbourhood Spirit Grant Recipients for 2018.

The Neighbourhood Spirit Grant program is a partnership between The City of Abbotsford, Vancouver Foundation, and the Abbotsford Community Foundation. The purpose of the grants is to support projects within Abbotsford neighbourhoods to reduce isolation, increase crime prevention, and support beautification efforts. The program received a record number of 38 applications for 2018, a 50% increase from last year. Successful projects were selected by a community vetting team and must be completed by November 2018.

The \$17, 235 in program grant funds were donated by the Abbotsford Community Foundation, and Vancouver Foundation, with the City of Abbotsford providing the application coordination.
